THREE NEW MASTER PHOTOGRAPHERS

At the last PAGB Awards for Photographic Merit (APM) adjudication, hosted by the NCPF in Gateshead, the standard and the pass rate in all sections was very high. 38 photographers achieved the Credit award (CPAGB), 22 were awarded the Distinction (DPAGB) and 3 people achieved the coveted Master award (MPAGB). A full list of all the awards is attached with this newsletter.

The next APM adjudication will be in Surrey on 25/26 April 2009. This is now fully subscribed and entrant packs will be sent out in January. All sections will run except Credit Slides and Master Slides where insufficient entries were received. We will continue to run the slide sections as long as we receive sufficient entries but if that is your preferred medium it would be wise to enter as soon as possible. Normally, we need a minimum of 5 entrants to run a section.

The November 2009 adjudication in Scotland will offer the first opportunity to apply for Credit and Distinction awards with Projected Digital Images as well as Prints and Slides. Entries are already coming in. If the numbers become too large we will consider an additional adjudication.

The **FIRST GREAT BRITISH SMALL PRINT CIRCUIT** closes on 26 January.
