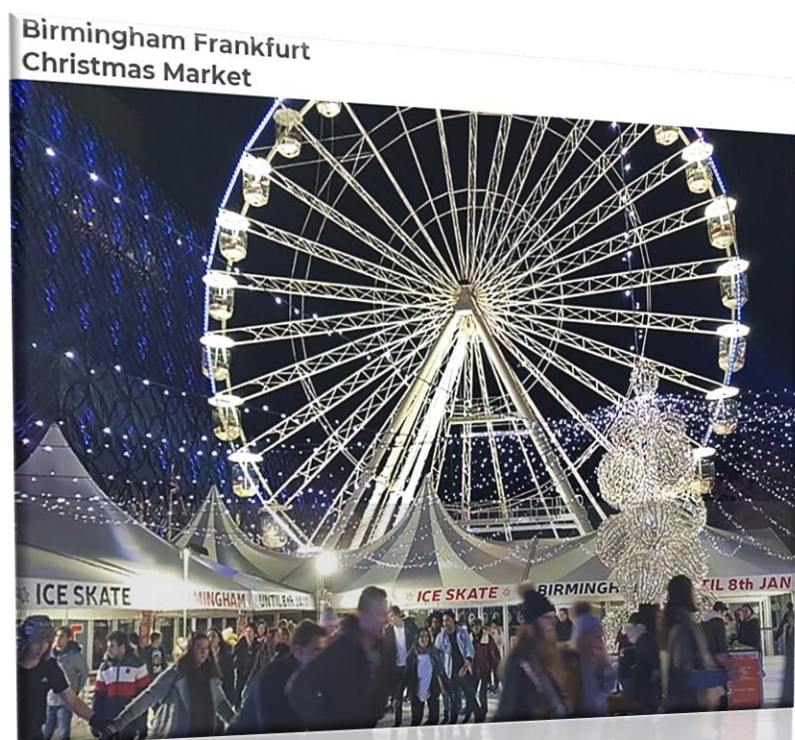
Please do not be discouraged. Without your entries there could be no exhibition and, without the high quality of your entries, the exhibition would not be as exciting as it is.
