ADVANCED NOTICE TO 2017 APPLICANTS

In the light of this years' experience of working with the new "FIAP Salon Database", I am aware that FIAP are planning to introduce a number or procedural changes for 2017. Whilst I do not yet have full details it may be helpful for members to be made aware of the potential changes. Please note though, we are not talking of changes to the criteria requirements.

There are now around 500 salons with FIAP patronage each year. It is therefore wholly impractical to expect the sole FIAP official who deals with your applications to even attempt to store that number of catalogues in his home, let alone try to work his way through them to validate your applications for distinctions. The use of the FIAP Salon Database is therefore essential.

If that is the case then it follows that until the salon report files have been put in the database, there is no way the system can function effectively. It is therefore perhaps not unexpected that the FIAP Directory Board has already taken the decision that no **account will be taken of acceptances and awards until the salon has submitted the report file to FIAP**. They have laid down rules about the submission of those files but, despite it appearing a simple matter, enforcing the rules is never as easy as at first seems. There were problems in 2016 and I expect a few in 2017, but eventually things will settle down.

Experience of using the database will, I believe, result in some changes to the design of the FIAP Dossier file, which applicants have to complete. I doubt the changes will be substantial, but I do expect some. One in particular may well be that the title will have to appear on every line in future and that, to overcome the problems this will cause to validation processes, there may have to be an extra column requiring a title number.

The FIAP Photo-Card is becoming increasingly significant to the process of validation. It is also a fact that in some parts of the world the FIAP Photo-Card is a highly prized possession with forgery, and other dubious practices occurring. The design has been enhanced to include a hologram and in future the number on the card will not change, becoming effectively a unique identification number, which will help in working with the FIAP database.

I understand that in future the inclusion in the dossier file of the **FIAP Photo-Card Number may** become an absolute necessity for ALL applications for distinctions. This may mean that, for AFIAP applicants, we may have to amend the procedure for obtaining FIAP Photo-Cards.

Finally, from my experience this last year, I am changing one of my recommendations to applicants. This is in respect of the number of titles, acceptances etc that you should include. Whilst in the past I have advocated a 'few' extras, I will now be recommending including as many as you practically can. I know that for EFIAP applicants looking towards EFIAP Bronze this may mean a bit of a balancing act in certain circumstances, but the revised advice is well founded. FIAP LIFE CARD PROMOTION

The new Director for FIAP cards has further developed this highly coveted badge and has assigned a hologram to it as a security mark. As of now each photographer will have a consistent ID-number - and for the first time this will allow clear identifications in the event of applications and distinctions.

For a limited time from now until July 15 2016 at the latest, FIAP offers a free exchange of cards to all current holders of FIAP Life Cards with an issue date between 2000 - February 2016.

The individual order form, together with a current photo, (correctly sized - details on form) has to be emailed to the Director Balasi Csaba to arrive not later July 15 2016. The form and the required photo should be sent, as separate attachments, to fiaplifecard@gmail.com

The newly produced Life Cards will then be given to Dave Coates, our Liaison Officer during the FIAP Congress 2016 in South Korea and he will distribute them on his return.



OPENING OF THE 6th FIAP EXHIBITION CENTRE

Following the highly successful opening of the FIAP Colour Print Biennial Exhibition at the Smethwick Photographic Society clubrooms last year it was suggested that the clubrooms would make an ideal FIAP Exhibition Centre.

The Smethwick Committee discussed the proposal and decided that a formal application should be made to FIAP. The application proved successful and it was announced that the 'Old Schoolhouse' (SPS) would become the 6th FIAP Exhibition Centre in the World and the first one in the UK.



The Official Opening by the FIAP President, Riccardo Busi, took place on Saturday 4th June 2016, rather appropriately, with the exhibition of the 2016 FIAP World Cup, which of course was won by Smethwick PS

Also in attendance were Roy Thomas, the President of the PAGB, with Gordon Jenkins, PAGB Vice President, and Ian Bailey, President of the Midland Counties Photographic Federation.

The Smethwick P.S. President, Mike Sharples, introduced Riccardo Busi, who said how pleased he was to open this 6th FIAP Exhibition

Centre and recalled his last visit to the building when he opened the FIAP Colour Print Biennial last year. Mr Busi presented Roy Thomas with a FIAP Medallion to symbolise the friendship between FIAP and the PAGB. He then presented a FIAP Flag to Roger Parry, the Secretary of Smethwick PS, and FIAP Head Scarves to Barbara Lawton, the SPS Immediate Past President and to the Queen of Smethwick, Judith Parry.

It was gratifying to see so many people at this event, some of whom had travelled considerable distances. The day was concluded with dinner for the official party cooked, in the Clubroom kitchens, by Judith Parry and her team of volunteers.
