

My photography, which started way back with the Brownie 127, received a jolt when my brother brought back colour slides from his time on Christmas Island with the RAF. From then until quite recently I have never been without slide film in my camera, often with another with print film in as well. I joined Northallerton CC in 1984 and, in 1998, I was the first person to enter a digital print into competition and also, in 2011, the very last person to enter a slide in competition. Today, I use a DSLR almost exclusively,



turning more to prints than PDI. My great joy is the landscape, often overseas, but also in the Yorkshire Dales or the Lakes, or anywhere I can find some light. I have helped out with the Northern Counties Salon for many years and I am a Past President of the NCPF, currently its webmaster, a job I also do for my club. 




