You will have noted in the last issue of **e-news** that the Top 8 Clubs now qualify of right to take part in the 2010 Inter-Club Print Championship and this should afford an opportunity to many other clubs who have been unable to qualify in past years.

(This same rule will also apply to the 2010 PDI Championship at Warwick).

So the same Top Clubs as last year but in a rather different order. Perhaps the most creditable performance was the small (but perfectly formed) North Wales club, Eryri, who made the Final at their 11<sup>th</sup> attempt and finished in a very creditable 7<sup>th</sup> place.

The Judges, Chris Palmer, Malcolm Kus and Richard Speirs did a great job, displaying consistency and giving lots of high scores.

Although not quite perfect the quality of the images projected on to the huge screen was much better than in previous years. We will continue to refine our technique and next year the projection will be even better.
