The ideal format for the cover of e-news is a Square Composition, which allows for a headline and a photo credit with a short paragraph underneath.

If you cannot provide your picture as a Square, please send it anyhow and we will try to fit it in.

We do not require a large file. Around 1500px X 1500px is ideal, saved as jpeg Q10 and file-named Photo Title by Author Name.

We would particularly appreciate images which celebrate an occasion, such as St David's Day, Mid-Summer Day, Mayday, Halloween, Christmas, etc. Or perhaps, just the season – Spring, Summer, Autumn or Winter.

But we will consider anything.

The Editor can never guarantee that you will get the Cover but you are almost certain to appear in an issue e-news.

Barring accidents or oversights, the photo will normally be credited to you, but please see the note below.

Note. Submitted photographs may be used in further issues of e-news and may be cropped, altered or overwritten to be published as the "button" to link from a notification e-mail to the e-news issue, as advertisements for e-news or other PAGB services or on banners and display material at events. Images used in this way, especially if cropped or overwritten, might not be credited to the photographer.

YOUR FEATURE IN e-news

If you would like to feature an important Federation or Club event you should contact the Hon. Editor in the first instance.

No guarantee can be given that there will be sufficient space in any issue, but anything which it is believed will be of interest to readers generally is acceptable. Announcements and adverts for purely Federation or Club events are not normally suitable for e-news.

Interesting, illustrated articles by, or about, individual photographers are also welcome, especially if you have a story to tell about a project, a journey or a challenge.

Unless otherwise agreed, an article should comprise 100-300 words and 4-8 images. More can be provided, if you wish, for the Editor to choose from. The images will be available to view on the **e-news** website, even if they cannot all be used in the newsletter.

The words should be sent in MSWord or in the body of an e-mail. We reserve the right to edit although this will be sympathetic.

Images should be sent as jpeg saved at Q10, not smaller than 1000px on the long side. We can resize larger files, but not smaller files. They should be file-named **Photo Title by Author Name** which will be embedded on the image when it appears on our website.

You may also provide a link to a website, a gallery or more information about the feature.
