



We aim to look at 850 images on each day - Print and PDI combined, so you will see the need to apply as early as you can.





HELP AND ADVICE

I receive quite a lot of enquiries about how much help you can receive with your images. In particular, in relation to the Masters of Print, several people have asked if it is acceptable that they have not printed themselves.

The entire ethos of Camera Clubs is to provide an environment where enthusiasts can meet to share their images and experience, to help and encourage each other to improve their photographic skills. So there are no PAGB rules limiting the help that you may have beyond the requirement that you actually captured the image, and of course any component parts, yourself.



You can even have help processing the image provided that you are in control of the changes made. Normally, you should no the result you want even if you need help to achieve it.

In the end, you are the only person who can decide if the print is still your own work or if you received so much help that you cannot now see it as your own work. If someone else does the printing are you happy that this is the image you intended?
