





GPU has many titles and distinctions (too many to detail here) based on 3 methods (soon maybe a 4th)

- Firstly, GPU CROWNS based on the traditional acceptances in international salons.
- Secondly, there are GPU VIP awards which are based on the "gold medal winning images".
 Think of the BEST of the BEST images. VIP is VERY IMPORTANT PHOTO.
- Thirdly, there are GPU awards (Aphrodite, Hermes & Zeus) based on photographic panels of images (similar to the UK Royal Photographic Society and now also PSA schemes).
- These awards are prestigious and represent achievable merits for all photographers. We believe these titles and distinctions are the "best in the world".

- Each member can have his/her own gallery in GPU web page.


