BADGE AWARD OF THE PAGB. (BPAGB)

Entrants must have been active members of an affiliated Club for a minimum of 2 years.

7 Prints are required and the images needed to achieve the Badge Award can be described as approaching "Good Club Photography". Photographs which meet the requirement for BPAGB will probably do well in an Advanced Section of their internal competitions or in Inter-Club competitions, the kind of image which a Club may sometimes choose to represent them in Federation events. A more detailed description can be found <u>HERE</u>. Whilst this is the first step it still is a standard that has to be achieved and it comes with a unique badge, a certificate and the admiration of your Club members. If you think your work is of a higher standard, you can of course apply at a higher level.

To be fair, with three more images of the same quality, Kathy would have probably achieved the CPAGB, as would all of the BPAGB entrants at this Adjudication.

























badges and, like other recipients, wear it with pride at photographic events.




Every accepted photographer is appointed to the Hall of Fame and will have the opportunity to be featured in e-news in their own






This is a great opportunity to view, handle and discuss the Prints which were Accepted and Awarded medals.




