This award is designed to recognise the Club who makes the most effort to support the MASTERS OF PRINT and will be calculated as 1 point for each print submitted plus the average score per print multiplied by 10.



#### DIAMOND CLUB AWARD

This award is designed to recognise the most successful Club in the MASTERS OF PRINT and will be calculated by the average score per print multiplied by 10 plus 10 points for each Print accepted to the exhibition.

#### PLEASE, GIVE YOUR MEMBERS THIS OPPORTUNITY!





This is a great opportunity to view, handle and discuss the Prints which were Accepted and Awarded medals.



I confess that I have had a box of the new Cotton Portrait Rag paper for some weeks without thinking of trying it. My favourite papers are more from the traditional Baryta range but I felt that it was time to experiment a bit, trying the same image on different types of paper.. My illustration obviously cannot show you the prints quality but which did I prefer. The Oyster rendered it just a little too

contrasty for my taste but I could have adjusted that in Photoshop. Distinction was a tad cool for this particular image so it came down to a choice between Gold Silk and Portrait rag.

At 315 gsm and 305gsm, both have a comfortable feel. I appreciated the gentle texture of the Rag paper which was kind to the skin tones and I felt that the blacks were rendered with more depth on the cotton surface.

In the end, my personal preference remained with Gold Silk as the glossy surface and higher contrast gave a sharper appearance. However, this is very much a personal choice. I will show these experiments around the Clubs and I suspect that many people will prefer the appearance of the Cotton Rag. Rod Wheelans MPAGB MFIAP FRPS FIPF HonPAGB Hon


A respected judge and lecturer with her own unique, quirky, artistic imagery. Her kindness and generosity to others always at the forefront despite her significant medical challenges in recent years





# Amateur Photographer of the Year Here are some of the best camera club entries to round three of APOY 2025 - Close-ups and Details





#### Erika Howard, London

Costa Rican glass frog Canon EOS R5, 100mm macro, 1/160sec at f/13, ISO 400

This tiny frog is only 2-3cm in length, and Erika's image is exactly what a macro shot should be - an insight into a minuscule world. She has managed the green-on-green of the composition beautifully, allowing the edges of the leaf on which the frog is resting to fall

away into black, while using its curves to frame the little amphibian. She has also placed it on the thirds when composing, which is exactly right for the subject. We even have what appears to be eye contact, and we can't ask for much more than that. A picture that demonstrates that even encounters with creatures as small as this can be memorable. Erika also wins 100 points for her camera club, Hampstead Photographic Society.

#### Colleen Jackson, South Manchester Camera Club

Face in abstract Canon EOS R5 Mark II, 100mm macro, 1/160sec at f/2.8, ISO 100

This blend of two shots of a rusty surface has resulted in an image that almost looks as if it has been taken from space. The contrast of the golds and blues is sumptuous, and there's a wonderful texture to the picture, too.






#### Marriam Hughes, Littlehampton Camera Club Portrait of a tulip

Canon EOS 750D, 90mm macro, 1/125sec at f/8, ISO 100

The delicate pattern on this tulip's petals has been beautifully realised. The jet black backdrop works well, too. 4= Stafford Photographic Society 70

Redhead

Nikon D750, 24-120mm, 1/320sec at f/20, ISO 3200

A beautifully textural study of a Highland cattle. Including part of its horn in the frame is a clever touch.

Abstract rain

Canon PowerShot G3 X, 40mm, 1/636sec at f/6.3, ISO 125

A stunning abstract that raises more questions than it answers, which shows the power of a highly original photograph - which this is.
