This award is designed to recognise the most successful Club in the MASTERS OF PRINT and will be calculated by the average score per print multiplied by 10 plus 10 points for each Print accepted to the exhibition.

The Society of International Nature and Wildlife Photographers (SINWP) is urging photographers worldwide to submit their best bird images now - the Bird Photographer of the Year 2025 competition closes on 31 October 2025.

This prestigious contest, run in aid of the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds (RSPB), has raised over £16,138 to date through past competitions.

With entry priced at a minimum of £1 per image, **100% of donations** go directly to the RSPB to support their vital work in protecting avian wildlife and habitats. The overall winner receives the Bird Photographer of the Year 2025 trophy and certificate, one year's free professional membership of SINWP, a copy of the Anthropics Collection, among other rewards.

CLUB ORGANISERS -Please encourage your members to enter for the MASTERS OF PRINT.

If you make a club entry, all of your members can enter 1 to 5 prints at just £3 each print and there are lots of valuable prizes to be had by Clubs and Individual entrants. And think of the great prestige an acceptance brings to your Club!

And why not organise a Club Entry?

Entry as an Individual.

A maximum of 5 prints may be entered, divided amongst the three Categories in any way. The fee for an Individual entry is £15, even if you enter fewer than 5 prints.

Entry by a Club.

The Club may collate the work of any number of Photographers, who hasn't entered as an Individual. A maximum of 5 prints per Photographer may be entered, divided amongst the Categories in any way. The fee for a Club entry is £3 per print with a minimum Club Fee of just £15

APPLICATIONS FOR MFIAP **CONCESSION FOR 2025**

FIAP have recognised that changes to the rules for the application of MFIAP were introduced at short notice and could adversely affect those who are already working towards application for MFIAP.

The new rules for 2026 require applicants for MFIAP to have achieved EFIAP/platinum to qualify for application for MFIAP whereas previously the applicant was only required to have achieved EFIAP.

Those who have already achieved EFIAP but not EFIAP/p are invited to apply for MFIAP as soon as possible. The closing date for receipt of such applications is 1st December 2025.

If you would like to apply for MFIAP please contact your FIAP Liaison Officer as soon as possible as there are processes to be completed before the application can be submitted to FIAP by the FIAP Liaison Officer.

DATA (Use and Protection) Act 2025

After three attempts across two governments this Act has finally arrived. The Act has many parts with Part 5 involving updates to existing Data Protection legislation. Part 5, Section 70 is of interest to us and the effect is described in an Appendix to our existing data protection advice.

Put simply, our guidance previously advised that Clubs, Federations and the PAGB should include in their entry rules a request for permission to store required personal data. With the new Act this is no longer necessary although, if such a statement exists, there is no need to remove it.

(With thanks to our Standards and Government Chair, Mark Buckley-Sharp, who has followed the progress of this Act assiduously, even the excitement of reading Hansard from time to time. Service genuinely "above and beyond"!)

STUDENT

I know that there are a few students amongst our readers who might want to check out this opportunity - There is still time to enter the **European Student Award** of the **Sony World Photography Awards 2026** — a free-to-enter, global competition for anyone aged 18–30 undertaking a photography programme.

Sending unmounted prints to exhibitions and events, such as the MASTERS OF PRINT.

Simple packaging is highly recommended for unmounted prints, usually just a left over paper box or something similar is quite adequate. Even a rigid envelope, maybe with a little extra card to strengthen it.

There is no need to interleave each photograph with padding material or cardboard and, please, do not send every print in its own plastic sleeve – these just get thrown away and it's a waste.

Keith Suddaby, passed away peacefully at the age of 91 at his nursing home in Newbiggin-bythe-Sea




